CANADA: “When I first heard about the Opportunity Collaboration, I declined to attend. It seemed like too much of a commitment of time and money,” says Gerhard Pries of the Saronia Investment Funds. “But in a subsequent conversation, I heard something that struck me: the event was not going to be just another meeting of the minds with lots of talking. The organizers insisted that they wanted deals struck; they wanted to see ‘ink on paper.’ I changed my mind and decided to go.”

Shortly before Gerhard attended the Opportunity Collaboration, his triple bottom line impact investment firm, Saronia Asset Management Inc, launched a new fund to invest in the private equity markets in developing countries. “We believe private capital is part of finding effective solutions to global poverty and environmental issues. The Opportunity Collaboration was a place I could talk with others about it, and find individuals who were looking for a place to invest their money. I’m happy to say we found some of them.”

Directly as a result of relationships formed at the Opportunity Collaboration, the Saronia Frontier Markets fund gained approximately \$2 million in new investment capital. According to Pries, “Any new investment has follow-on effects. These investments could, in the next years, blossom into much more. I’m very optimistic about that.”

If we want to be results-oriented, and not just spend another 5 days being friendly, then we have to be clear about what we’re looking for from others, and what we can offer to them.
