My Personal Capital

We set the stage by helping the kids take stock of their complete personal value, including human and social capital. Participants finish by pooling their capital, illustrating the leverage they can draw on by working together.

Clean Water Business Challenge

A hands on entrepreneurship exercise that challenges participants to learn about and tackle an issue facing millions of children around the world —lack of clean drinking water. They will then construct a water filter as a way of understanding how science and engineering can be used to solve many problems in the world today.

Out of the Box Entrepreneurs Part 1

Designing a Business for Good —

Participants work together in a mad-libs style to devise an idea and create a prototype for a purpose-driven product or service. They are then split into teams to start their own Business for Good.

Out of the Box Entrepreneurs Part 2

Getting Down to Business —

Participants will brainstorm and create an abbreviated business plan, including competitive analysis, funding options, marketing strategy, and pricing.

Out of the Box Entrepreneurs Part 3

Finishing Touches —

Participants finalize their business plans and practice their presentation skills with their peers and Delegate mentors
